Key Message 2: How we are funded

How we are funded

Only a small percentage of our funding comes from the NHS. The rest is made possible by the generosity of our community through donations, gifts in wills, fundraising events, charity shops and the dedication of our volunteers. This support enables us to offer expert care free-of-charge for all, for as long as they need it.

Government funding covers a fraction, you make the rest possible

We're independent of the NHS and receive just 31% of our care funding from government and statutory sources. The rest, over £10 million each year, must be raised through the incredible generosity of our community. It costs around £21,000 every day to keep our hospice care running. Every pound you give helps make sure families can access expert, compassionate care when they need it most without worrying about the cost.

Our care is always free of charge, but it's never free to provide

Whether someone is cared for in our Inpatient Unit or supported at home, the cost of delivering that care including medical care, counselling, spiritual care, therapies, and bereavement support can be up to £21,000 per day. But for the families we support, it's always free of charge. Because of people like you, no one has to choose between comfort and cost at the end of life.
